

Changes

As many who were in church last Sunday or tuned into the broadcast on Facebook there was a noticeable change in the service music. The liturgy moved from Setting 8 to Setting 3, the words are mostly the same only the tune is different. It's unique in that it binds us to the Church of every time and every place. It evolved from the old Hebrew synagogue traditions that early Christians knew and the teachings of Christ. Becoming the Mass as an amalgamation of practices from churches and councils all around the Roman Empire then, within the Church itself and even today subtle changes continue to be made.

At the time of the Reformation Martin Luther decided not to break with the tradition that the people were comfortable with; he understood the people had to be involved. As Pastor Paul Himmelman, son of the President of The Pittsburgh Synod in the 1950s, explained *(paraphrased);* In church the congregation isn't the audience with the pastor asking God to perform but rather **God is the audience**, the pastor the director, and the congregation the actors!

From the very opening the congregation is put to work by asking God's indulgence either in the short Greek version, Kyrie - Lord have mercy, or the Hymn of Praise either from the Angel announcing to the shepherds, or festive Resurrection and victory. At each step we respond to the hearing of God's word with thanks or ask for it as in, "Lord to whom shall we go, You have the words of eternal life."

Arriving at the Communion we first extend a greeting to what we are about to come to us, at Communion we ask to be worthy recipients through grace, and afterward we depart joyfully knowing God goes with us!

The service is the work of the people. I invite all to participate as we are all the actors with God as our audience. \sim

Risk-taking Witness

What makes a good leader? Confidence, compassion, or courage? Popularity and prestige? A quick Google search offers no shortage of books, articles, and classes on leadership. And it's no wonder: organizations, communities, and entire governments depend on the abilities of those who step into decision-making roles. A good leader can inspire the masses and impact the world in profoundly positive ways, while a corrupt leader can cause entire systems to crumble, resulting in devastation for individuals and communities alike.

It turns out these concepts are not new. Scripture has much to say about the qualities of leaders and the consequences of their decisions. The Bible offers several stories of faithful leaders: those who think about what is best for the whole community, particularly the people who are most vulnerable. These kinds of leaders follow God's call at great personal risk. John the Baptist is just one example.

Meanwhile, corrupt leaders are most concerned with self-preservation. They are governed by fear and greed, easily threatened by those on the margins. Herod finds himself in this position. While he may have been intrigued by John, saving his own reputation mattered more to him than John's life. The result is nothing short of horrific, culminating with an innocent man's head on a platter.

Our world is full of leaders who wield their power for their own benefit. But the good news is, God continues to call faithful leaders who pave the way with risk-taking, truth -telling witness. This type of leadership is not easy, and the personal risk is great. John's story illustrates this in alarming ways. And yet, John's story is not defined by his death—in Christ, his prophetic words and deeds echo through the ages. His impact lives on, calling us to the humble, compassionate way of Jesus.

So, what kind of leader will you be? And whom will you choose to follow? ~



Upcoming Commemorations

Bartolomé de Las Casas, missionary to the Indies, died 1566 Wednesday, July 17, 2024



A native of Spain, Las Casas first came to the Western hemisphere while serving in the military. Upon arriving in the West, Las Casas was granted a large estate with Indigenous enslaved people whom he freed after he was ordained a priest. He worked in the Caribbean and Central America to improve the lives of the native peoples.


