



A Day of Celebration

This past week on Thursday, July 4, 2024, our country celebrated the 248th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. There were parades, picnics, all manner of public presentations and, of course, fireworks. It is one of the few federal holidays exempt from the Uniform Monday Holiday Act of 1968 which took effect in 1971.

It is significant that the members of the Continental Congress did not credit their own wisdom or ideas for such a document but in something greater than themselves!

"We hold these Truths to be self evident, that all Men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among them are Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness."


The Independence of colonies from Great Britain which would later be known as the United States of America. After the Declaration was approved and sent to the printers, John Adams wrote to his wife of July 2, "... Independence Day will be celebrated by succeeding generations ... as the Day of Deliverance by solemn Acts of Devotion to God Almighty.

Jesus only references government with, "Render unto Cæsar the things that are Cæsar's, and unto God the things that are God's." St. Paul in Romans elaborates about being subject to governing authorities and encourages good citizenship while holding the Kingdom of God as the first priority.

To this point Evangelical Lutheran Worship, the new red book, has lessons and a prayer for a national holiday, one very appropriate that we should ponder this weekend.

Lord of all the worlds, guide this nation by your Spirit to go forward in justice and freedom. Give to all our people the blessings of well-being and harmony, but above all these things give us faith in you, that our nation may bring glory to your name and blessings to all peoples, through Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord. **Amen.** ~

In today's gospel reading, Jesus sends the disciples out on their own (in pairs, but without him) to spread his message, and he gives them a packing list: no food, no bag, no money, no extra clothes—only the love and power of Christ, and the good will of the people they would encounter to support them. The disciples must have felt woefully unprepared. And yet Jesus sent them anyway.

As Christians, we may feel unprepared for our journeys. We know that the Lord has sent us out into a broken world to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ, but . . . How do we do that? What do we say? What if people don't want to hear the message? Isn't it impolite to discuss religion? Surely the disciples shared those concerns. But they went anyway, trusting Jesus. And in trusting Jesus, they found that his message of repentance and salvation was well received. "They cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them."

Perhaps this story can serve as inspiration in our own vocations. Although we may not know how to tell others about the love we've found in Jesus, we know that Jesus is supporting us in our meager efforts. We may fear rejection, but Jesus tells us to shake the dust from our feet and carry on. If we worry that we won't get it right, we can remember that the word of God does not return empty. In your baptism, Jesus has called you into his family. In holy communion, he nourishes you for the journey. Throughout your life, he gives you a story to tell others, and the power to share his good news. Take courage, Christian, and go forth in his name. He's got your back! ~

Benedict of Nursia, Abbot of Monte Cassino, died around 540 Thursday, July 11, 2024 Benedict is known as the father of the Western

monastic movement. Educated in Rome, he went to live as a hermit, and eventually gathered a community of monks around him. He

wrote a rule for living in monasteries that is used by Benedictines and adapted by others.



Nathan Söderblom, Bishop of Uppsala, died 1931 Friday, July 12, 2024

A winner of the Nobel Prize for peace for his efforts to unite peoples after the First World War, Söderblom also called attention to the revival of early church worship principles, and helped to lay the groundwork for the World Council of Churches.


